Dear Parents and Carers

I hope you are enjoying the sunshine.

Following the Government announcement made this evening, we plan to go ahead with our plans to open the school to more pupils as of 1st June 2020. If you requested a place for your child, you should have by now received a letter in the post detailing when your child is expected in school. The letter was sent 1st class post last Friday, although I have spoken with one parent today who has not received it yet, others have let me know they are looking forward to their children returning. If the letter has not arrived and you requested a place, please make contact with your child's class teacher who will give you more information. I have received confirmation today from transport that all the transport requested has been agreed.

If you usually transport your child to school yourself, please be aware that staff have been instructed not to engage in conversation with you on site, all correspondence will be in the home/school book. If you wish to speak to your child's teacher, it will have to be via phone or email after all pupils have gone home. It is a busy time for the staff at the moment, ensuring all pupils whether in or out of school have work provided, so please be patient if you don't get to speak to them immediately.

As I stated in the letter for parents who did not want to send their child back to school at the moment, you may change your mind as time goes on. We will of course look to accommodate them if you do change your mind, however please be aware that it may not be possible for at least a few days, in reality over a week, as I will need to alter the planning that is in place, ensure we have adequate staff for safety reasons whilst still maintaining reduced sized classes as per Government guidelines.
