Literacy

Literacy: This term in Literacy we will be exploring three texts (fiction/poetry/ non fiction.) We will be focusing on characters, descriptive language and mark making using the interactive board.

Communication: This term in Communication we will be focusing on making choices, music and plays skills. We will give the children opportunities to choose the songs, instruments, and games they want to play with.

Phonics In Phonics this term we will continue to learn letter sounds, identify letters and write them. Some of our pupils will start blending. We will introduce a group story using the picture cards from RWI where children will be able to identify the cards and practice the sounds.

Problem Solving and Reasoning

Numeracy: In Numeracy we will be looking into money and quantities. We will also explore fractions related to food and we will finish the term learning about geometry focusing in 2D shapes.

Here are some of the other things we are covering this Term:
