

Stories and Songs:

Our sensory story this term is going to be Zippo the Super Hippo. This is about a hippo that really wants a superpower. During the story his friends help him to find out what superpowers he has already.

During the sensory story we are going to be exploring lots of different textures with our hands. When exploring we focus on using both hands together and reaching across our bodies for the different objects.

Literacy and Phonics:

In our Phonics lessons we are working towards our individual phonics targets. For lots of us, this includes focusing on books. In our storytime sessions we look at lots of different books. We are learning to look at the pictures in the books and locate some of the animals and people we might see on the page.

Problem Solving and Reasoning:

In maths this term we are focusing on moving objects by pushing. We are going to be doing this through lots of different activities including building towers out of big blocks and pushing them over. We also going to be using both hands to push cars down ramps.

In our hand function lessons we are going to be exploring playdough. In these lessons we are going to be focusing on using our fingers. We will be squeezing and squashing the playdough and then using all of our fingers individually to make holes.

Other Curriculum areas:

Music: During our resonance board session we are going to be learning about St George and the Dragon for St George's Day. Art: In Art this term we are focusing on ripping and sticking, we are going to practising these skills when making lots of pictures to display around school including flags for St Georges Day.
