

Stories and Songs:

Our sensory story this term is going to be The River by Marc Martin. The story is about a river that flows around the country through different countryside and cities. In our story we are going to be listening to the different sounds we might hear in these places and textures we might find. These include the mud on the farm and the water when the river eventually flows into the sea.

Literacy and Phonics:

In our phonics lessons this term we are focusing on sharing stories with our peers. We are going to focus on a story called The Little Fox. This story is about a fox that explores his forest and finds lots of sounds and animals along the way, the story also features lots of repetition and rhyming words.

In our story time sessions we enjoy looking at lot of different books. We are learning to look at the pictures in the books and locate some of the animals and people we might see on the page.

Problem Solving and Reasoning:

In Maths this term we are focusing on matching and things that are the same. We are going to spend time exploring objects that are the same colour and shape. We are also going to be playing a game as a group where we have to guess which shadow the piece of clothing belongs to.

In our hand function lessons we are going to be developing the strength in our hands and learning to pull different objects. We are going to be pulling and unthreading pipe cleaners out of different toys and objects.

Other Curriculum areas:

Music: During our resonance board lessons we are going to be listening to a story about a squirrel called A Safe Place.
