

Stories and Songs:

The children will have individual reading books linked to their reading abilities and phonics level or a free choice if they have completed their phonics learning. We will be collecting some books from the library about Great Britain to share and find facts and information from. We will also be looking out for new and interesting books to share in class.

Literacy and Phonics:

All of our literacy skills will be delivered through either 'Read, Write, Inc.' phonics or our focus texts for our theme. We will be developing our reading comprehension skills in a wide variety of ways.

We will be focusing on 'holding' a sentence, repeating it a number of times so that we can then write it independently.

Maths:

Our first maths unit is all Number and Place Value. We will be making sure that we can form our numbers correctly and write the number names independently.

Our second unit is Calculation where we will be focusing on multiplication at first. We need to become fluent in the 2, 5 and 10 times tables to support our understanding and calculation of money in future units.
